

SUMMER CARE

- If you go to the pool or beach, completely saturate your hair with water and apply leave in conditioner. Not only does this protect your hair absorbing the water, but it also helps prevent tangling and matting that can occur more easily when exposed to chlorinated or salt water.
- After swimming, wash your hair with a color safe clarifying shampoo, condition, and then reapply your leave in conditioner. Take time to comb out completely to ensure no tangles or matting occur.

SUMMER CARE

- Anyone with blonde or highlighted extensions....
- Do not get sunscreen on your extension hair. This can alter the color of extensions. Hair can turn gold, orange and even pink.
- Just as sunlight can lighten your natural color, exposure to sunlight can alter the color of your extensions. Use a leave in conditioner with a UV protectant to protect your hair.

RECOMMENDED SUNSCREENS

- You want to find sunscreens without oxybenzone and avobenzone. These are the ingredients that cause extensions to turn orange. Unfortunately these stains rarely come out of extensions completely.
